Atlanta BeltLine Partnership (ABP) mission is to fulfill, protect, and preserve the Atlanta BeltLine vision by raising funds and building partnerships that *Enable* the Atlanta BeltLine project, *Engage* the public, and *Empower* residents in surrounding neighborhoods.

The Empower Program portfolio works to understand the challenges to equitable health, housing and economic opportunity that impacts residents of the Atlanta BeltLine neighborhoods, and provide programs that connect them to partners and available resources.

Home Empowerment Workshops

ABP's Home Empowerment workshops are designed to assist residents in BeltLine neighborhoods connect with providers and learn about available resources as they face pressures to sell and impacts of rising property taxes.

ABP works with experts in our community to conduct the workshops. Our partners include, Atlanta Legal Aid, Atlanta Volunteer Lawyers Foundation, Atlanta Habitat for Humanity, Atlanta Land Trust, Atlanta Community Toolbank the City of Atlanta, Grove Park Foundation, and more.

- Resources available to help homeowners stay in their homes
- Property taxes and tax exemptions
- Renters' rights in the state of Georgia
- Home buying resources and if home ownership is right for you
